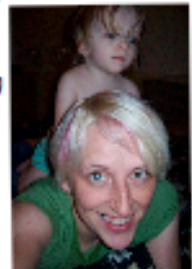

In early Oct, I spent two weeks in San Diego, sleeping on an arcade floor, praying daily with Lou Engle and the Call team for the preservation of marriage in California. I then flew back to KC to prepare for our fall mission tour to the West USA. Our trip started with 3 days in Conroe, TX, assisting in worship for a regional "Prayer Storm" event. **We then embarked on an 18 day trip to the West; ministering 16 times in 14 cities in 5 states.**

So much happened, it would be difficult to recap all of it. Highlights include Bakersfield, CA where 8 churches came together to fill a small "dome" for a night of worship and ministry. The Call San Diego hosted 30,000 people. We played again before the actual start of the event. Our time felt fruitful, as the Lord met us with His Presence, and I believe released a grace on the entire day. "In His quiver He has hidden me...." I don't mind being a secret agent of the Lord, intercessors have that privilege. **God answered our prayers at the Call! Amidst a strong liberal sweep in the elections, marriage was preserved in California.**

Despite all the ministry we've been privileged to do, October was our most difficult month financially. Of the approx. \$1,100 of monthly support pledges we live by, only \$275 came this last Oct. We are currently exploring various streams of income to allow us to continue to give ourselves (time / energy) to reaching western culture. A huge part of that will continue to be monthly personal supporters! Next month we will be looking to raise support for '09. Please pray about you or your church supporting our mission in '09.
